


How to Create ACHIEVEMENT BADGES






ShareTheRide achievement badges help promote trip tracking by awarding fun images on the User's dashboard after they track the required trips. Badges are customizable and shareable on social media. THIS IS A TWO-PART PROCESS: First, create the tag that defines what it takes for users to earn the achievement badge.

Second, you will create the Achievement Badge displayed on the user's dashboard after they meet the requirements. On the left are examples of earned badges.

Creating the tag:

Log in to **ShareTheRide.com**. In the blue navigation bar at the top of the screen, go to MANAGE, then **SMART TAGS** in the column on the left.


When the page opens, click the green button • NEW TAG in the upper right corner of the page.



Basic information:

In TAG NAME, tell what it takes to earn the badge. We suggest something like "Log 12 trips" or "Clean Air Hero." You can even create "Levels" by selecting the same modes but increasing numbers of trips required.

In **DESCRIPTION**, put notes to help you remember the details and why the tag was made. Note: Your users will not see this description.



In **Network Restrictions**, select your network.





















In CRITERIA, we recommend selecting Triplog for the Evaluation Method, because most tags are based on the number of trips taken.

The **CRITERIA** panel will open with options.

Slide Add a Triplog Start Date Restriction and Add a Triplog End Date Restriction to the right to turn them on (blue). Select the dates during which people can earn the badge. This example is for December 2021.





In What modes are eligible?, select the mode(s) eligible to earn this badge.

Select a value in What type of value should be **considered?** In this example we used **Trips** to match the Tag Name.

Fill in the number of trips required to qualify for the badge. You can also add trip goals and mile goals.

In Restrict eligible trips to specific sources? we suggest leaving No Restrictions Enabled.

This allows users to qualify for the badge whether they track their trips on a computer or the **ShareTheRide** app.



The check marks on the upper right side of the page should be green. Click the green **CREATE TAG** button.

You are ready to create the **Achievement Badge** your users will see.


















Creating the badge:


From your ShareTheRide dashboard, select MANAGE and ACHIEVEMENTS.

When the page opens, click the green **NEW ACHIEVEMENTS button in the upper right corner of the page.




In BASIC INFORMATION, enter the ACHIEVEMENT **NAME.** This will be visible to your users.

Fill in the **DESCRIPTIONS** users will see before (locked) and after (unlocked) they complete the requirements to earn the ACHIEVEMENT BADGE. In this example it's 12, to match the information we put in the tag.



In **Start Date**, enter the current date. This will make the badge visible on users' dashboards. In End Date, fill in the last date the achievement can be earned.

In **Icon URL**, paste a link to the image for your badge.



When you find an image you like, right click on it to copy the image link/address. Paste the link into the Icon URL area. We use IMGUR for finding images and links.

Once the image has been uploaded, you'll see a thumbnail of it on the screen.





















How to Create | ACHIEVEMENT BADGES

Click the blue **PREVIEW NOTIFICATION** button to check the image and resolution.


The next two buttons are grey, or not selected. We suggest you leave them that way.



In Network Eligibility select your network in the Which Networks Are Eligible? and Which Networks Managers Can Edit/View Report? fields.



In Claim Options, search for the tag you just created in the box called **Achievement to be earned by acquiring** the following tags and select it.



Everything should be green and ready for you click the green CREATE ACHIEVEMENT button.

Once saved, a QR code will appear. Clicking the code will show you what the badge will look like when it is earned by a user.

NOTE: It takes time for the system to process tags and achievement badges. If your tag is not visible within a couple of hours, please contact ShareTheRide@valleymetro.org for assistance.
