



ACME INDUSTRIES TRAVEL REDUCTION PROGRAM PARTICIPATION INCENTIVES

Become an Alternative Mode User (AMU) to gain benefits not offered to coworkers who commute by driving alone. AMUs carpool or vanpool, take the bus or light rail, ride their bikes or walk during the commute. Below are examples of the rewards you can earn by being an AMU.

1. Register as an AMU to enter prize drawings. Carpool or vanpool, take the bus or light rail, ride your bicycle or walk to enter to win a \$25 Visa gift card.
2. New AMUs are eligible to receive a reward valued at \$5 if they use an alternative mode at least 4 times within a one-month period.
3. Registered AMUs can participate in the Guaranteed Ride Home program in case of emergency. Rides are provided by taxi limited to three uses per year.
4. We provide preferential parking for carpoolers located near the employee entrance. Six spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. You must be a registered AMU and have a carpool dash tag to use them.
5. Showers are available for employees who bike or walk to work. They are located in the basement.
6. A bike rack is located by the front doors.
7. Even if you aren't a regular AMU, you can do your share to help clean our air on High Pollution Advisory days and we'll give you a cookie! To become a registered AMU, please see Wile E. Coyote in Human Resources or at wile.coyote@acme.com. Join us in the fight against air pollution and traffic congestion in the Valley of the Sun.

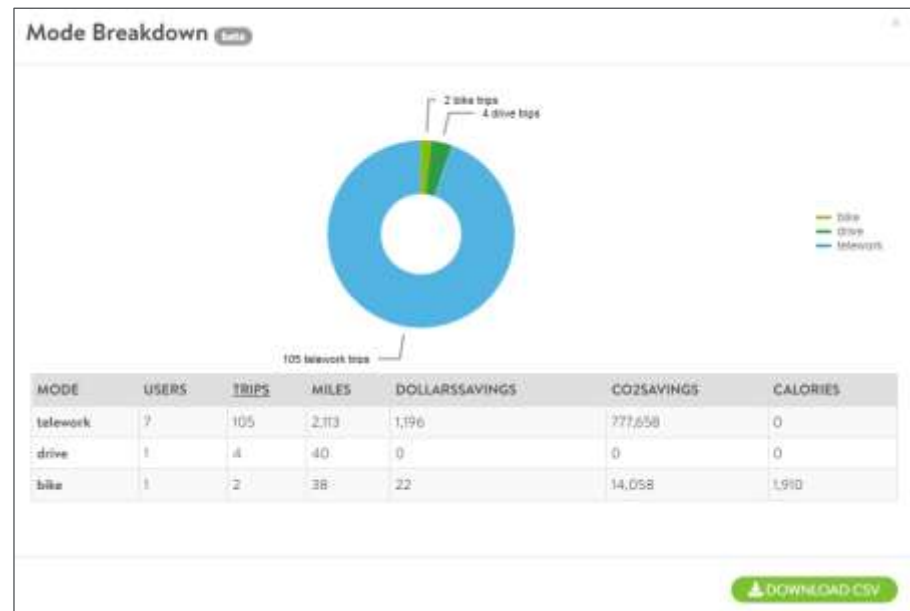
